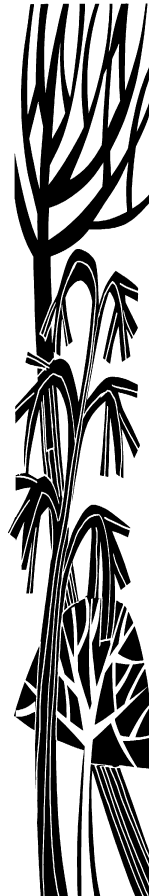
New Translation of the Roman Missal: As of the first Sunday of Advent 2011 the new translation of the Roman Missal is now obligatory throughout the Catholic Church in most of the English Speaking world. During this time we also remember our posture and gestures at Mass (bowing, striking the breast, when to stand, sit and kneel, receiving Holy Communion with reverence) as an outward expression of our inner faith.

Schola We now have a new 'schola' to assist with singing the Mass on Sunday at 12 noon. Practice is open to all, from 11am every Sunday in the church. This new initiative will help us to sing the parts of the Mass according to the new translation.

CTS Missal Copies of the Sunday and Feast day Missals with the new translation of the Mass are available at the stall, £18.

Sacrament of Baptism – Enrolment Baptisms will now take place on one Sunday each month. Enrolment for February baptisms now closed. Enrolment for the March 4th Baptism takes place from 6pm on Monday February 6th. Please email or telephone the parish office for an appointment time. You will then be asked to attend a Baptism class with the Godparents on Thursday 16th February 2012 at 7pm in the Church Hall.

EWTN is a global Catholic television interwork that provides many useful and interesting programs. It also broadcasts a daily Mass at 1pm GMT and is repeated at 6pm GMT and 11pm GMT. This is something which may especially benefit those who are housebound and otherwise cannot make it to church for Mass. Sunday Mass is broadcast at 1pm GMT and 11.30pm GMT.
