*We can prepare for Mass by **silently** recollecting ourselves in God's presence. Before receiving Holy Communion, if we are ready, we are asked to make some preparatory act of **reverence** such as a genuflection or bow; this should be made while the person in front of us is receiving. It is also good practice to spend some time in **thanksgiving** after receiving when we return to our places.*

Bishop Robert Barron - How can we communicate the joy and wisdom of the risen Christ to those around us - especially to those who seem indifferent or even hostile to Christianity? The acclaimed Catholic author, speaker, and theologian Bishop Robert Barron of Los Angeles is to come to Scotland in an attempt to answer these vitally important questions. Bishop Barron will be speaking at the Usher Hall in Edinburgh on Thursday 6th September on the topic of 'Proclaiming Christ in Our culture.' The event begins at 7.30pm, tickets are £10 (£6 concession). I highly recommend taking advantage of hearing this speaker.
